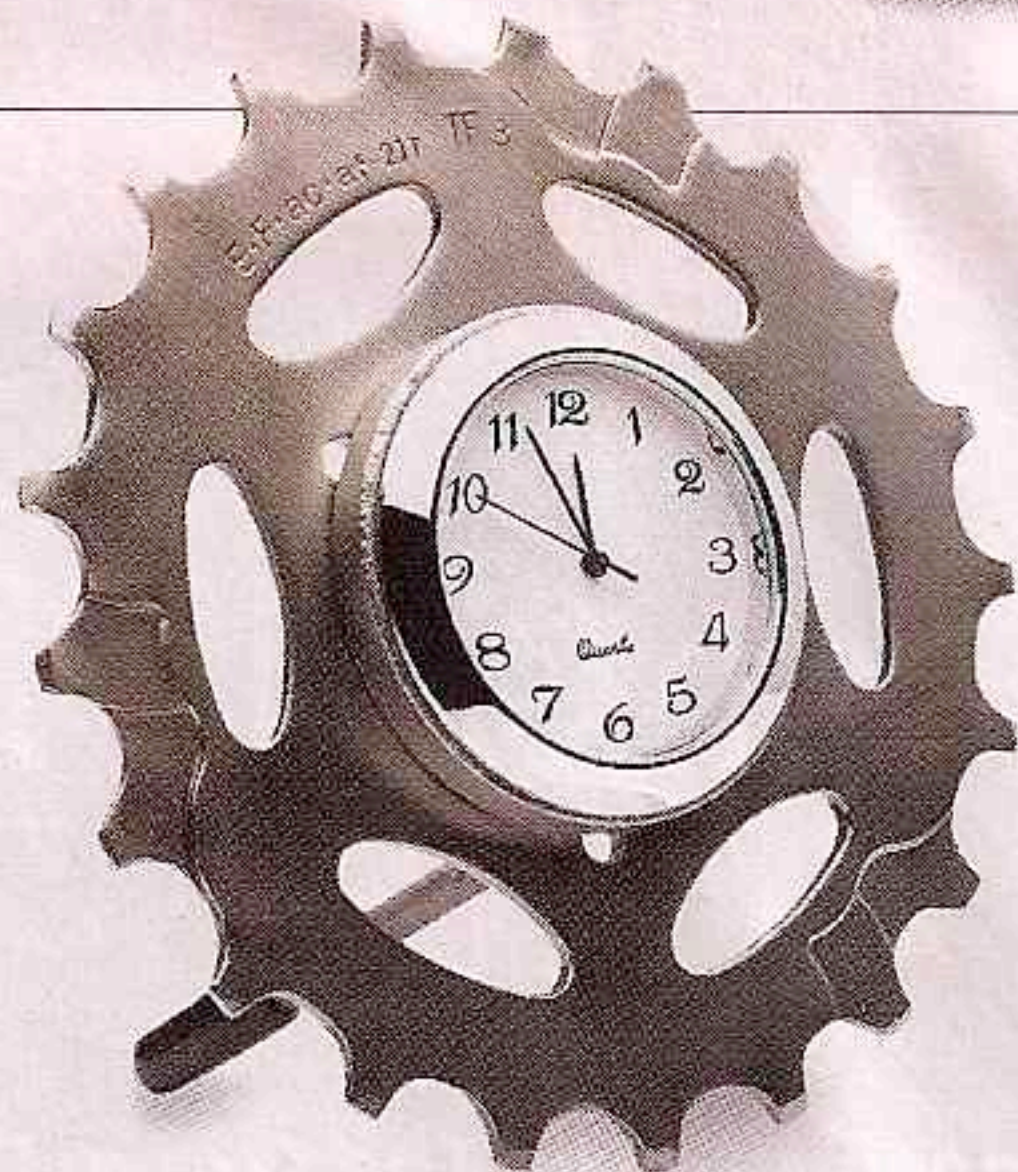


» **Two-Tone Temptress**
